These vineyards share similar characteristics with the best sparkling wine vineyards in the world. Greensand and chalk soils allow the vines, in each of the separate sites, to flourish across the south of England.

Premium Wines

White Wines

“La Rocca” Soave Classico Pieropan, Garganega, Italy **£85.00**

The grapes were grown in the vineyard of 'La Rocca', which takes its name from the adjacent medieval castle and fortress ("La Rocca") that dominate the town of Soave, just east of Verona. The soil is unique in Soave in that it is a limestone outcrop (the same soil as in Valpolicella Classico) in a sea of basalt. Because of this soil, Pieropan feel they get sufficient ripeness in the Garganega to make a wine solely from this variety.

Condrieu, Domaine de Bonserine, Viognier, Rhône Valley, France **£135.00**

The vines of Condrieu are grown on steep, low fertility, rocky slopes, often in terraced vineyards, with constant challenges from soil erosion and wind. Here producers get the most from Viognier grapes creating rich and intense wines.

Russian River, Chardonnay, Paul Hobbs wines, California, USA **£135.00**

This cool region within Mendocino County is one of the most sought after from winegrowers for its stunning quality of chardonnay and Pinot Noir Grapes. The mild climate all year long and the morning fogs that protect vines from the summer heat gives all the necessary time to the chardonnay variety to ripen slowly and give a wine second to none.

Red Wines

Côte-Rôtie “Côte Brune” Domaine Giles Barge, Syrah, Rhone Valley, France **£170.00**

This is the most northerly of the Rhône appellations with incredibly full and deep wines. This wine is sourced from “Côte Brune”, the warmest area with steepest vineyards that get most of the intense sunlight and gives, at the moment of the harvest, rich and incredibly sweet fruits.

Pine Ridge, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California **£180.00**

Grapes of this wine have been sourced from some of the best sites within Napa Valley; Stags Leap District, Oakville and Rutherford AVAs. The aim is to give a beautifully complex Cabernet from Napa, velvety and plush, with great structure and polish.

Bodegas Lan “Culmen” Rioja Reserva, Tempranillo, Graciano, Spain **£185.00**

The grapes were hand harvested from 40 to 60-year-old vines from a single vineyard ('pago') called 'El Rincón' on the 'Viña Lanciano' estate. This is one of the most spectacular vineyards in the Rioja Alta region, located on a bend of the River Ebro. Protected from the winds and cold weather by the Sierra Cantabria mountain range and its proximity to the river, the vines enjoy stony, poor soils, which are conducive to low yields, while lower temperatures ensure an enhanced aromatic dimension to the wines.
