### White Wines

**“La Rocca” Soave Classico Pieropan, Garganega, Italy** **£105.00**

*The grapes were grown in the vineyard of 'La Rocca', which takes its name from the adjacent medieval castle and fortress ("La Rocca") that dominate the town of Soave, just east of Verona. The soil is unique in Soave in that it is a limestone outcrop (the same soil as in Valpolicella Classico) in a sea of basalt. Because of this soil, Pieropan feel they get sufficient ripeness in the Garganega to make a wine solely from this variety.*

**Condrieu, Les Mandouls, Domaine Ferraton, Viognier, France** **£160.00**

*The vines of Condrieu are grown on steep, low fertility, rocky slopes, often in terraced vineyards, with constant challenges from soil erosion and wind. Here producers get the most from Viognier grapes creating rich and intense wines.*

**Pine Ridge, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** **£190.00**

*Grapes of this wine have been sourced from some of the best sites within Napa Valley; Stags Leap District, Oakville and Rutherford AVAs. The aim is to give a beautifully complex Cabernet from Napa, velvety and plush, with great structure and polish.*

**Pommard 1er Cru “Les Chanlins”, Thomas Morey, Pinot noir, France** **£195.00**

*Les Chanlins is a Premier Cru vineyard at the very southern end of the Pommard commune in Burgundy. Located on the steeper slopes of the Cote d'Or, the rocky vineyard is well suited to Pinot Noir, making a structured, full-bodied red wine with some spiciness*

**Côte-Rôtie “L’Eglantine Rouge” Ferraton Pere & Fils, Syrah, France** **£235.00**

*This is the most northerly of the Rhône appellations with incredibly full and deep wines. This wine is sourced from “Côte Brune”, the warmest area with steepest vineyards that get most of the intense sunlight and gives, at the moment of the harvest, rich and incredibly sweet fruits.*

**Sine Qua Non “The Thrill of Stamp”, Syrah, California, USA** **£525.00**

*Sine Qua Non (commonly abbreviated as SQN) is a California winery that is known for its wines made from blends of Rhône grape varieties, a very limited production of wines that are difficult to obtain. Each release is allocated and directly sold to a carefully managed mailing list of customers. As of 2018, the wait to join the mailing list was approximately 9 years. The winery is located in Ventura County and was founded in 1993 by Austrian Manfred Krankl, who emigrated to the US in 1980  
The name of the winery, Sine Qua Non, is a Latin phrase that can be translated as "absolutely indispensable".*
