MEETING & EVENTS

There are three meeting rooms on the lower ground floor of Vintry & Mercer, each inflected with individual character and distinct style, in a part of the hotel that is secluded and quiet.

Features include large LED screens, top-of-the-range audio and visual equipment, wireless connectivity, Apple TV, mini-bar fridges, Nespresso machines and high-speed wireless internet.



THE MUSIC ROOM

The Music Room is one of London's most stylish meeting rooms and private dining venues, seating up to 10 people. Features include eclectic teal blue wall panels, a standout boardroom table influenced by Isambard Brunel's famous engineering, and a bespoke carpet inspired by the British Regimental tiles. Colourful, iconic British album covers decorate the walls. It's a place where guests can meet, dine and listen to music on the record player — using the room's collection of records, or their own favourite vinyls.



THE LIBRARY

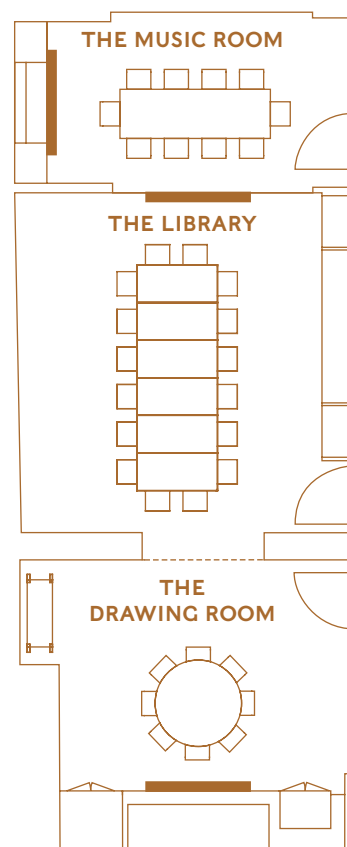
The Library is a reflection of London's history as a trading entrepôt, with the ceiling decked in an enormous vintage trading map taken from old travel books. With a capacity for 32 seated and up to 35 standing, this room is the largest of the meeting spaces, and can be hired for private use, offering an informal setting for working lunches, laidback dinners or business meetings. For larger events or even more space, *The Library* and *Drawing Room* can be interconnected.



THE DRAWING ROOM

The Drawing Room is a stylishly intimate space for smaller meetings and private lunches or dinners, accommodating 10 seated and up to 25 standing. The history of the area is played out in the design — wine red walls and a bold, limited edition map of the city. There's also a French panelled ceiling and a copper mesh chandelier. *The Drawing Room* can be interconnected with *The Library* for larger dinners or drinks parties, as well as daytime meetings.

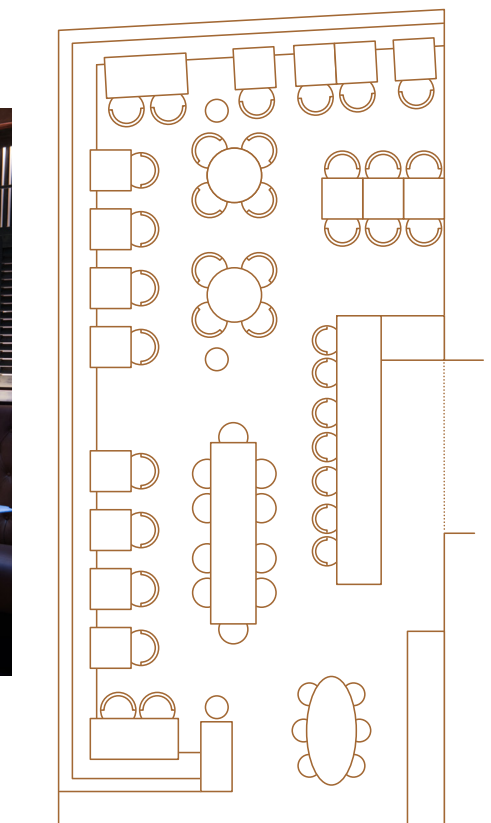
Vintry Kitchen is a relaxed, all day Café and Wine Bar on the ground floor, serving breakfast in the morning and café-style classics throughout the day. Wine is central to our approach — close to the hotel, merchant sailors landing from Bordeaux used to store their wines and in a nod to our past we serve wines tapped straight from large

barrels lining the gantry, alongside a selection of cheeses, charcuterie and other snacks.

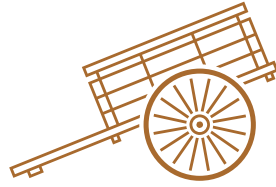
Vintry Kitchen is available to be hired privately for events and can accommodate up to 60 guests seated or 100 standing

MERCER ROOF TERRACE

It is at Mercer Roof Terrace, on the top floor of Vintry & Mercer, that old and new truly collide. In one sweep, the view takes in London's skyline, from the dome of St Paul's Cathedral to the glass tip of The Shard.



At Mercer Roof Terrace, dinner can be served al fresco above the city lights. Inside, the atmosphere is warm and convivial, with floor-to-ceiling glass doors opening wide to the night's sky. The menu celebrates the best of British cooking, using sustainably sourced meat and fish from the British Isles. Food is matched with English wines, as well as New- and Old-World Classics. Cocktails include inventive recipes using house-infused spirits displayed in large, colourful glass carafes on the bar.

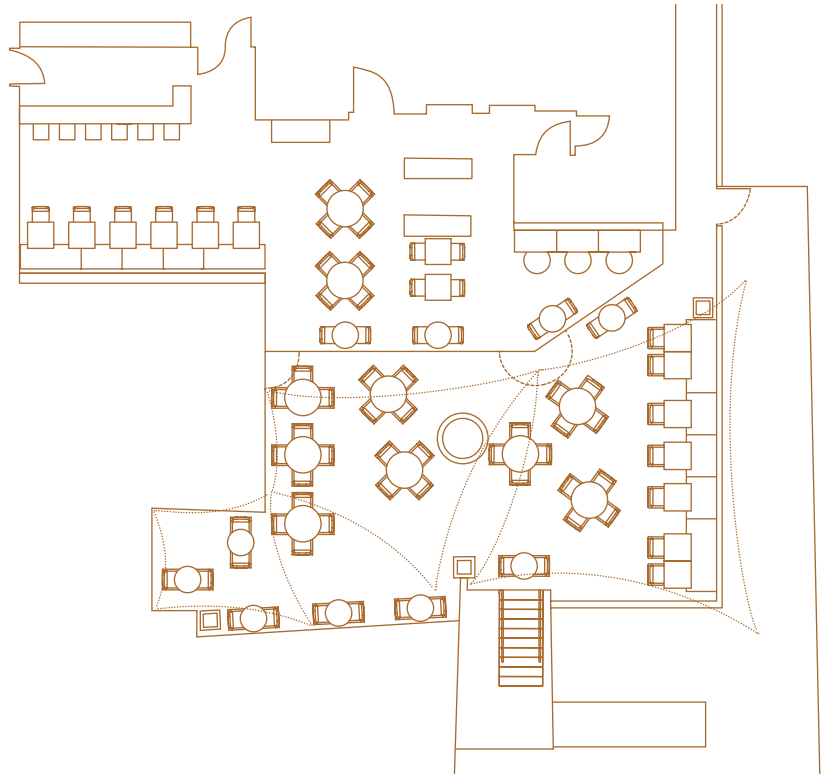

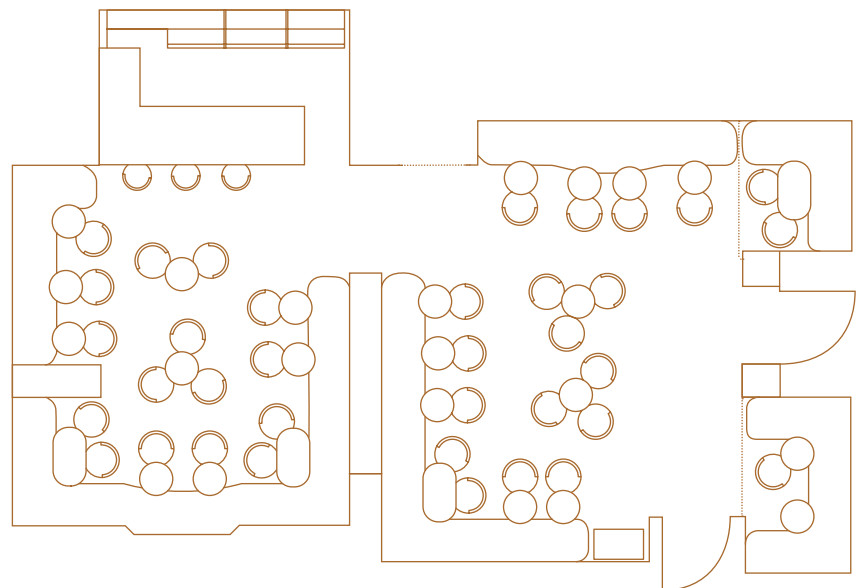
Do Not Disturb is available for Private Hire and can accommodate up to 60 people seated or 100 people for standing events.
